Tasting Notes:

Varietal, fresh rain on a dusty road, pepper, chocolate covered cherries, ripe strawberry, marjoram, and mincemeat carry through to a pleasant and balanced center. Quaffable drinkability.

Winemakers Notes:

Produced in a drinkable fruit forward and rich style. Aged 21 months in French oak cooperage to develop a well-rounded wine with firmly structured tannins for delicious drink ability.

Vintage Notes:

Grown on steep mountainous terrain in the higher elevations of the Shenandoah Valley of Amador County, California. There was a big fire starting just before harvest began lasting into mid harvest (Caldor Fire). It started 10 miles northeast of us and burned in the opposite direction. So, all our 2021 wines escaped having any smoke taint. Lower yields of extractive fruit due to drought. No heat spikes during the growing season. Just a dry year with little moisture in the ground. Look for dark colored extractive wines, but not a lot of
